


Gerkin Celebrates 75TH Anniversary



Gerkin Windows & Doors will be celebrating 75 years of business in 2007! The company was founded by Virgil Gerkin in Sioux City, Iowa in 1932. The first products sold were oil burners and rock wool insulation, which at the time were new to the market. Virgil was always interested in making homes energy efficient. Later, in the 1940's, Gerkin starting manufacturing storm windows and storm doors. The company was first known as Gerkin Home Modernizing. By the early 1960's the company was run by Virgil's sons Jim and Tom Gerkin and was known as The Gerkin Company. They soon went from selling retail to selling wholesale and added a line of aluminum windows, called "Weatherliner". This line was used for residential and commercial projects for over 30 years. After highly successful careers, the Gerkins sold the company to Midwest Energy, a local company that was publicly held. In 1991, the company was brought back to private ownership by Otto, Steve and Paul Schneider along with long time associate John Jones. Since this time, the company has grown six fold through new products such as a line of vinyl windows and doors called "Comfort Series", a line of commercial aluminum windows called "Rhino" and an upgraded line of storm doors called "Classic", Uniquely Yours" and "Cabrio".

Gerkin continues to strive for top quality products at a reasonable price. Under the leadership of the current management team, Gerkin has had record sales in 14 out of 15 years, including 2006! Gerkin's primary focus has been to manufacture high quality, energy saving window and door products. Throughout our 75 year history, we have continued to establish ourselves as an innovator in design and manufacturing capabilities. Dakota Premier is a new series of hardware with the same characteristics of Dakota but will be offered in lifetime finish options of oil rubbed bronze, pewter and brass hardware. Dakota Premier also comes with a matching interior hardware and a keyed deadbolt lock. Normandy is a newly designed painted lever hardware with a keyed deadbolt and heavy duty interior hardware. Seville has the same styling as the current Seville hardware which includes lever style hardware with a keyed deadbolt. It is also available in oil rubbed bronze, pewter and brass. The interior hardware on Normandy, Dakota Premier and Seville have been greatly improved over the previous hardware for operation and durability. 
Gerkin Introduces CABRIO

Gerkin Windows & Doors is proud to announce the addition of the "Cabrio" line of storm doors. This is the first all new line of doors that have been introduced since the introduction of "Classic" and "Uniquely Yours" over 5 years ago. Cabrio is a beautiful line of doors which feature retractable screens into the head of the door! As the glass panel is opened, the screen appears. This smooth operating glass panel is operated by two block and tackle window balances, which allows finger touch operation and stop points anywhere desired. The Cabrio offers a rugged 1-3/4" extruded aluminum frame with smooth rounded exterior features for a beautiful appearance. This double weather-stripped door also offers a weather tight fit with a frame that overlaps the jamb z-bars and head drip cap.

Cabrio is offered in three styles, fullview self-storing, high kick panel self-storing and low kick panel self-storing. All doors are available in a white finish and in standard sizes of 32" and 36" widths. There will be seven hardware choices for this door series, including four finishes of painted white, oil rub bronze, pewter and brass. Cabrio offers several options, such as, brass or pewter sill expanders, canopy head vent, kick panel plants and a pre-hanging option for easy installation.

Displays are available to fit into existing Gerkin door displays for a cost of \$150.

Agave of Sendero Hills Austin, TX

Texas Redwood, an Austin distributor for Gerkin Rhino windows is involved in a large development called Agave Contemporary Homes in Sendero Hills of Austin. Chris Krager of KRDB Design Build in Austin was instrumental in getting Gerkin Rhino windows into this large development. Chris discovered Gerkin through an article in Metropolitan Home Magazine, a national



publication, about architect Paul Masi, of Long Island, NY who built his ultra modern house using Rhino windows. With this discovery, KRDB started specifying Gerkin's clear anodized Rhino windows for their "Green" contemporary house designs. With the help of Texas Redwood, KRDB and developer Chris Czichos of Griffin Partners, the Rhino windows have made their mark in Austin. The Agave development has over 50 houses with Gerkin Rhino already built and is set for nearly 200 building lots. Similar developments are also being planned.

With well over a dozen architects specifying Rhino for housing, loft apartments and other projects, Austin has proven to be a great place to do business.
