In the winter of 1989-90 Gerkin began to conceptualize and design the Rhino Commercial window series. Today we have six commercial window styles in the Rhino line. This window series consists of a commercial horizontal slider, casement, single hung, hopper, awning and fixed windows.

Over the past two years, Gerkin has made dramatic changes in the hopper, awning, casement and fixed windows. Although the windows look the same on the outside, the internal structural changes are impressive! We made two major changes. The mainframe on all of these windows were changed from a single wall to a double walled extrusion! Along with this big change, we also strengthen the sash with double wall pockets. We then incorporated heavy corner gusset keys into these double wall pockets, which are power crimped into place. The result of these changes took us from offering just "commercial" rated windows to also offering "heavy commercial" rated product at surprisingly reasonable prices!

Our full line of "commercial" and "heavy commercial" rated windows are now being marketed nationally. Our commitment to top quality product, easy catalog pricing, quick lead times and four color options including anodized have given Gerkin a jump-start on the competition!

Recently there has been a growing trend to using clear anodized windows in large modern houses in urban areas. To highlight this trend, Gerkin was recently featured in a national publication where our anodized windows were used in a home on Long Island.

At Gerkin we are committed to building the best in every Rhino window! Our growth with Rhino has been strong and we continue to look ahead with new product designs and product innovations.

The C-60 / HC55 5100 Series Commercial Awning:

These windows are offering a 2 3/8" thermally improved frame in vertical or horizontal multi-window common frame configurations. Air infiltration rates are near zero with the use of dual bulb weather-stripping. Multipoint locks on each side of the sash are used to create a compression seal.

Our four bar friction hinges provide easy operation and tension adjustments. Washability hinges are available for roto operation or push/pull manual operation.

Gerkin eliminates the complaints of hard operating awnings by offering a heavy-duty roto crank mechanism, which offers extra cranking power and a low gear for smooth trouble free operation.

The C-60 / HC55 5200 Series Commercial Hopper Windows:

This 2 3/8" thermally improved frame features easy to use cam action locks with 4-bar friction hinges. Without the use of roto operators, this window offers the same tight fit at the awning or casement but with a more maintenance free operation. Gerkin uses cam locks to compress the weather seals in the tightest manner possible. These locks also include a pole ring, which will allow for operating the window at higher elevations. Four bar friction hinges will provide easy operation and tension adjustments.

The C-40/HC55/HC90 5300 Series Commercial Casement Windows:

The casement is full of features that blow the competition away! Gerkin eliminates the complaints of hard cranking commercial casements by offering extra cranking power and a low gear for smooth trouble free operation. Our gear teeth are close together, which remove extra play in an open sash and reduce the likelihood of damage.

Our multi-point locking system goes beyond the typical. This 3-point lock system is very forgiving with a wide operating tolerance. The use of secondary locks is no longer needed. The weather seal received from the system is incredibly tight and provides performance nearly that of fixed windows!

Gerkin uses four bar heavy-duty friction hinges that will hold up to a 90-pound sash and still provide easy operation. Washability and egress hinges are available for roto operation or push/pull manual operation.

Additional Rhino Features:

Our fixed and projected windows offer overall glass thickness options of 5/8" or 1". Gerkin also offers several stocked glass options as well as numerous special order options.

Gerkin offers complete subframe and panning systems, nail fins, flush face fins, snap trims, sill-flashing strap anchors, stacking frames, structural mullions, mullion covers and factory applied extension jambs. We also offer a louver system with insulated or non-insulated blank-off panels for PTAC units which are used in hotels.
